Prices to Compare – effective June 1, 2009

Here are Met-Ed's prices to compare by rate class. Your rate class is on the upper right hand corner of your Usage Report. Use your figure to compare the prices offered by different electric generation suppliers. You will save money if you buy electricity from an electric generation supplier for less than your price to compare. The figures below reflect a State Tax Adjustment Surcharge (STAS) of (0.08)%.

Rate Classes

Residential (RS)

7.485 cents per kWh, which includes 2.831 cents per kWh for transmission

Residential Time-of-Day (RT)

7.045 cents per kWh on/off peak, which includes 2.391 cents per kWh for transmission

General Secondary – Non Demand Metered (GS-Small)

7.644 cents per kWh, which includes 2.779 cents per kWh for transmission

General Secondary - Volunteer Fire Company

7.485 cents per kWh, which includes 2.831 cents per kWh for transmission

General Secondary - Volunteer Fire Company Time of Day

7.045 cents per kWh on/off peak, which includes 2.391 cents per kWh for transmission

General Secondary – Demand Metered (GS-Medium)

7.644 cents per kWh, which includes 2.779 cents per kWh for transmission

General Secondary Time of Day Service (GS-Large)

7.411 cents per kWh on/off peak, which includes 2.615 cents per kWh for transmission

General Primary (GP)

7.059 cents per kWh on/off peak, which includes 2.455 cents per kWh for transmission

Transmission Service (TP)

6.656 cents per kWh on/off peak, which includes 2.344 cents per kWh for transmission

Municipal Service (MS)

7.888 cents per kWh, which includes 2.553 cents per kWh for transmission
