

Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station



Located in Oak Harbor, Ohio, the 950-acre site is situated on Lake Erie, east of Toledo.

Facts At A Glance

- A pressurized water reactor produces 898 megawatts (MW) of electricity, enough to power 450,000 homes.
- The plant began commercial operation in 1978.
- The plant employs 833 people.
- The plant pays more than \$6.5 million annually in property taxes.

ENVIRONMENTAL MEASURES

- In conjunction with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, the plant operates and maintains the adjacent 730 acres of “Navarre Marsh” wetlands as part of Ottawa National Wildlife Refuge.
- The plant emits no pollutants into the air and reduces our dependence on fossil fuels.
