

**Report by FirstEnergy Corp. Regarding
Corporate Contributions to Entities
Operating Under Section 527
of the Internal Revenue Code**

FirstEnergy's Corporate Political Activity Policy governs contributions to entities operating under Section 527 of the Internal Revenue Code (the "Policy"). Under the Policy, FirstEnergy, is required to keep accurate records of corporate political contributions and to take actions to ensure that a report (the "Report") is published annually, including for each contribution, the amount and the name of the recipient. FirstEnergy is a member of certain trade associations that may use a portion of their membership dues for political contributions. In the event that such trade associations inform FirstEnergy of the amounts and the other breakdowns associated with political contributions, such information will be incorporated in the Report, subject to reasonable de minimis limits.

Pursuant to the Policy, the following is the Report for the period January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2009:
