Dear Secretary Johnston:

Pursuant to the Maryland Public Service Commission (“Commission”) Order No. 92488, enclosed for filing is The Potomac Edison Company’s (“Potomac Edison” or “Company”) proposed Grid Programs Surcharge which will recover costs associated with the Company’s approved Electric Distribution System Support Services Program (“EDSSS Program”).

Attached as Exhibit A is a clean copy of the tariff page for the Grid Programs Surcharge, as well as an updated Index page. There is no redline version provided for the Grid Programs Surcharge tariff page, as this is a new tariff page, but the Company is including a redline version of its Index Page within Exhibit A. The proposed effective date of the surcharge is November 1, 2026. While the Company expects to begin accepting applications into its EDSSS Program on October 1, 2026, which will be the start date of its two-year pilot period, it is requesting the November 1, 2026 surcharge effective date to allow time for review and approval from the Commission. The workpapers supporting the rates for the surcharge are attached as Exhibit B.

Potomac Edison will utilize deferral accounting. Any over or under-collection will be reconciled and reflected for refund or recovery, respectively, in the surcharge.

Potomac Edison would note that it has a proposal outstanding to include costs associated with its Energy Storage procurement in Case No. 9715 in its Grid Programs Surcharge. Should the Commission approve the Company’s request, an update will be filed to adjust the surcharge in accordance with that order.

GRID PROGRAMS SURCHARGE

Effective for all Service rendered on and after November 1, 2026, there shall be a surcharge at rates set forth below to recover costs associated with the Company's Electric Distribution System Support Services Pilot Program. Applicable bills rendered shall include an amount equal to the surcharge rate times the number of kilowatt-hours. The resulting charge includes an adjustment for gross receipts tax and the Commission assessment factor, is in addition to any minimum charge set out in the Rate Schedule and is added to the Customer's bill before any tax surcharge is levied against the Customer's total bill. Changes to the surcharge will be filed annually. Amounts billed hereunder shall be subject to late pay charges.
