



Stay Safe Around Overhead Power Lines

Overhead power lines carry thousands of volts of electricity. Accidental contact with a power line or anything it is touching may result in serious injury or death.

- If you are working near overhead power lines using aerial equipment or ladders, assume all lines are energized and keep equipment at least 10 feet away. If you need to get closer, contact us.
- If a drone or other object gets caught in a line, never try to knock it down or remove it yourself. Contact us at 1-888-LIGHTSS.
- If you see a power line down, stay at least 30 feet away and call 9-1-1.



STOP. LOOK. LIVE.

Remember these three words to help you stay safe:

- Always survey the area for potential electrical hazards.
- Identify where overhead power lines are located.
- Take precautions to avoid accidental contact with electrical equipment.
