

Structures, such as tree stands, attached to a transmission tower or pole or located underneath a high-voltage line—even temporarily—are prohibited. Contact with electric equipment can be extremely dangerous. When you're out hunting, always remember to:

STOP:

Beware of downed or damaged power lines.

 If you see a downed power line, keep yourself and others as far away as possible and call 911 immediately. Stay at least 30 feet away from distribution lines and at least 100 feet away from transmission lines and large towers.

LOOK:

Know where lines are located.

 Trees and brush can hide power lines. Look around to see where lines are located and use caution when hunting anywhere near power lines.

LIVE:

Shoot responsibly.

 Do not take shots in the direction of power lines or anything on them. Gunfire can cause outages, and can damage or bring down wires, which can pose a risk of serious injury or death to you and others.
