

HELP FOR HEATING BILLS

Winter is just around the corner, and so are your winter heating bills. Fortunately, the state of Ohio offers programs to help customers who need assistance.

After completing an application, eligible customers can receive financial assistance and possibly energy-efficiency improvements for their homes or apartments. TO QUALIFY: Your gross household income from all sources must be less than the following amount for the size of your household:

When determining households up to eight members for HEAP, SCP, and WCP, 175% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines (FPG) is used. For HEAP, SCP, and WCP households over eight members, 60% State Median Income (SMI) is used. PIPP and EPP for all household sizes is 175% of the FPG. When determining 200% of the FPG for HWAP, households with more than eight members must add \$11,000 for each additional member.
