

Discount Available

for Low-Income West Virginia Customers

You may be eligible for a discount on your electric bills from November 2025 through March 2026 if you receive any of the benefits listed below during these months:

- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
(SSI children under 18 are not eligible)
- WV WORKS
- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)

If you currently receive any of these forms of assistance, the West Virginia Department of Health & Human Resources (WV DHHR) will send you a letter explaining the special reduced rate program and an application to submit to Potomac Edison to receive the discount.

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Potomac Edison may automatically enroll your account on the 20% discount program if you were a participant last year. If we can enroll your account for you, you will receive a letter from Potomac Edison confirming enrollment.

If you do not receive this letter from Potomac Edison in October, mail the completed and signed application to:
