

# Discount Available

for Low-Income West Virginia Customers

You may be eligible for a discount on your electric bills from November 2020 through March 2021 if you receive any of the benefits listed below during these months:

- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)  
*(SSI children under 18 are not eligible)*
- WV WORKS
- Food Stamps (You must be 60 years of age or older)

If you currently receive any of these forms of assistance, the West Virginia Department of Health & Human Resources will send you a letter explaining the special reduced rate program and an application to submit to Potomac Edison to receive the discount.
