# Need help paying your rent/utilities due to COVID?

Through the COVID-19 stimulus package, the Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP) was created to assist renters with rental and utility assistance.

# **Program Guidelines**

- Payment period (arrears and future assistance): March 13th, 2020 December 31st, 2021
- Up to 12 months rental assistance Up to 12 months utility assistance

# **Eligibility Guidelines**

- ERAP is for renters only
- Households must have a gross annual or monthly income that does not exceed 80% of Greene County's Area
   Median Income (AMI) see chart below
- Households must demonstrate that they have been directly or indirectly impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic
- Households must demonstrate that they are at risk of homelessness or housing instability
