

- Based in Morristown, JCP&L serves 1.1 million customers in 13 counties within a 3,200-square-mile area of northern and central New Jersey
- New leadership, system enhancements and process improvements have strengthened our performance
- In 2015, JCP&L plans to spend \$267 million on projects designed to enhance service reliability and meet the increased demand for electricity
- 1,500 employees in New Jersey
- Approximately 1,500 retirees in the state
- Approximately 4,100 FirstEnergy shareholders in the state
- \$1.5 million in state and local taxes paid in New Jersey in 2014, including income, property and other taxes
- \$104 million in purchase of local goods and services in New Jersey in 2014
