

FirstEnergy Instructions to Outside Carriers

- When delivering / picking-up material at FirstEnergy (FE) locations, all drivers are required to communicate with an FE employee or FE authorized representative and perform a job briefing with that employee. **(Energy Delivery Accident Prevention Handbook (ED APH) 105.3)**
- Driver is required to engage the parking brake, chock the wheels and/or use dock locks, where available. **(ED APH 204.2 & 204.3)**
- Driver is required to open the truck or trailer doors / remove gates and remove rear load bar before loading or unloading. FE employee or FE authorized representative will assist driver in backing, if needed. **(ED APH 203.3)**

Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) Requirements for Vehicles

No vehicular equipment having an obstructed view to the rear may be operated on off-highway jobsites where any employee is exposed to the hazards created by the moving vehicle, unless:

1910.269(p)(1)(ii)(A)

The vehicle has a reverse signal alarm audible above the surrounding noise level, or

1910.269(p)(1)(ii)(B)

The vehicle is backed up only when a designated employee signals that it is safe to do so.
