## The Potomac Edison Company Maryland SOS Bid Results from October 22, 2012 Solicitation

## Residential

This solicitation was for two (2) twelve-month terms from June 1, 2013 – May 31, 2014, and two (2) twenty-four month terms from June 1, 2013 – May 31, 2015.

A total of four (4) bid blocks were offered representing 26.8% of the load and approximately 167.2 MW PLC at time of Bid. The requirement was filled.

There were nine (9) eligible bidders in the 2013 RFP Procurement Process of which seven (7) suppliers submitted bids and two (2) suppliers won the load offered.
